Public Anger and Community Decision Making

Visit with fellow planners and relax at the end of a long week. The Knickerbocker was built in 1904 as a Philadelphia style row house, and named after it's construction company. The building was originally designed as a hotel for individuals passing through the area, as well as for workers at the South Altoona Foundry of the Pennsylvania Railroad. In the 1940's the section of the building, which is now the tavern, was home to the Trod Brothers Store. In the 1950's the store turned into a bar called the Variety Room. The Variety Room closed in December of 1990 due to the failing health of the owners. On February 21, 1996, the bar was re-opened under new ownership, and a new name, The Knickerbocker Tavern. Today, the Tavern is home to a friendly, cozy atmosphere offering great food and the area's largest selection of Microbrewed beer. The food choices include homemade soups, award winning wings, appetizers, salads, sandwiches, and many specialty items.
