Return On Environment

A single-family home located within a 1/4 mile of protected open space has a property value that is \$14,600 greater, on average, than other properties in the community

tree cover removes 181,200 tons of carbon from the air per year, resulting in \$3,600,000 in annual health savings

25% of all tourism in the Lehigh Valley comes from recreation - the highest rate in Pennsylvania

Contact with nature has great health advantages like reduced stress + lower blood pressure

Wetlands, riparian corridors + forests provide important system services for water supply, flood protection + water quality

Lehigh Valley open space provides \$355,000,000 per year in water supply, flood control, pollination + habitat services

Lehigh Valley woodlands provide \$48,000,000 per year in pollutant removal from the air
