Participants will receive a crash-course in key organizing tactics for identifying, strategizing and implementing campaigns that increase active transportation investments in Harrisburg and surrounding communities. This workshop is an advocacy follow-up to the Navigating-MAP 21 Workshop (www.advocacyadvance.org/trainings) held on May 29.

Rarely do national bicycle advocates have the opportunity to visit Harrisburg, and we are excited to work with you to help shape local priorities into successful campaigns and strong organizations. This training is intended for any bicycle or pedestrian advocate who would benefit from gaining the tools to craft and manage campaigns to increase public funding for active transportation. Attendance is also appropriate for local government planners, health promotion agencies, elected officials and others who recognize the value of non-motorized transportation.

This workshop also serves as a great way to develop relationships with other advocates, agency staff, elected officials and bike/ped professionals.
