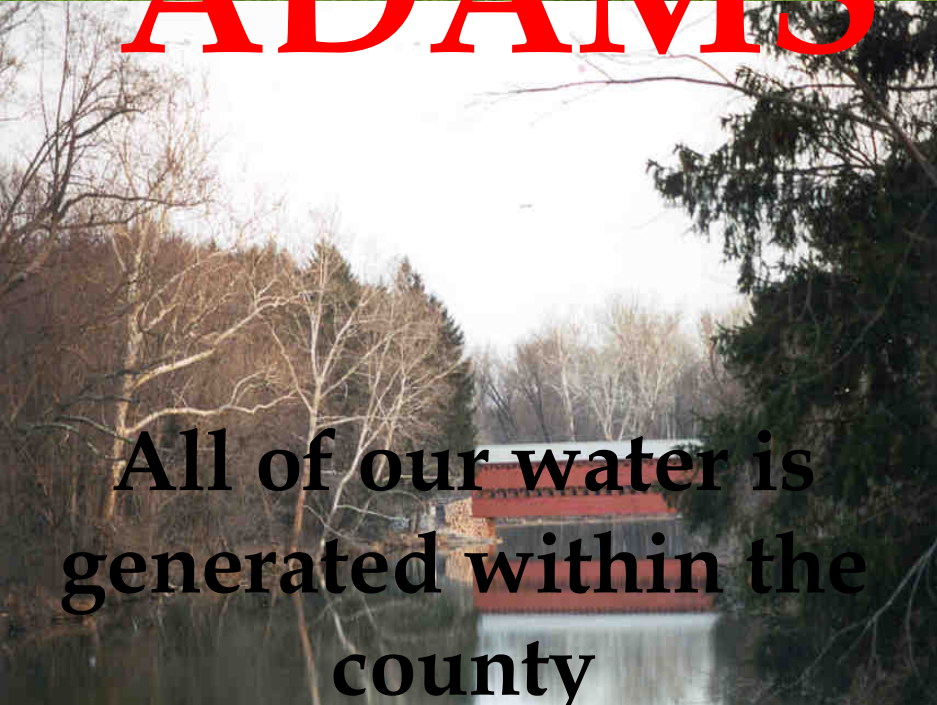

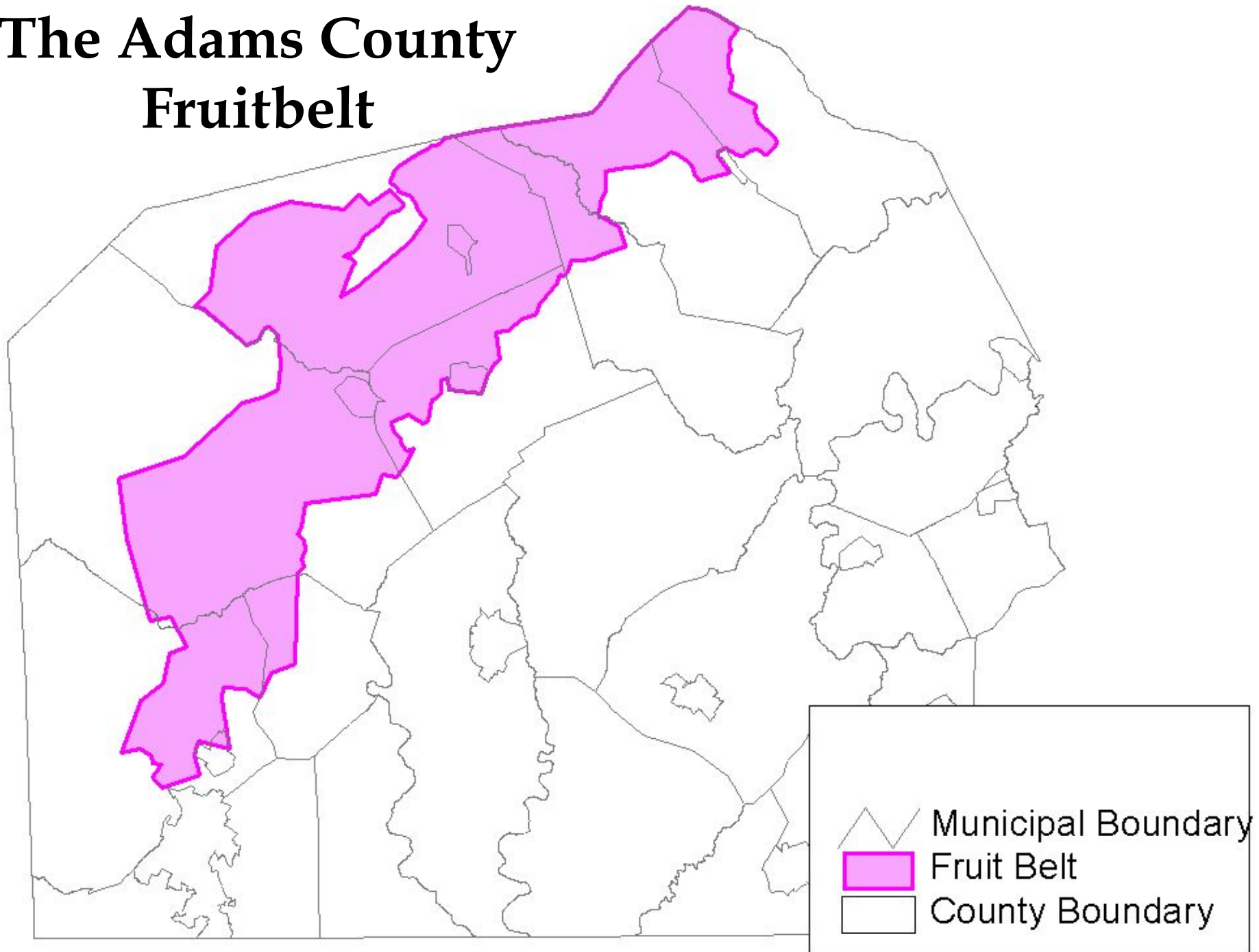

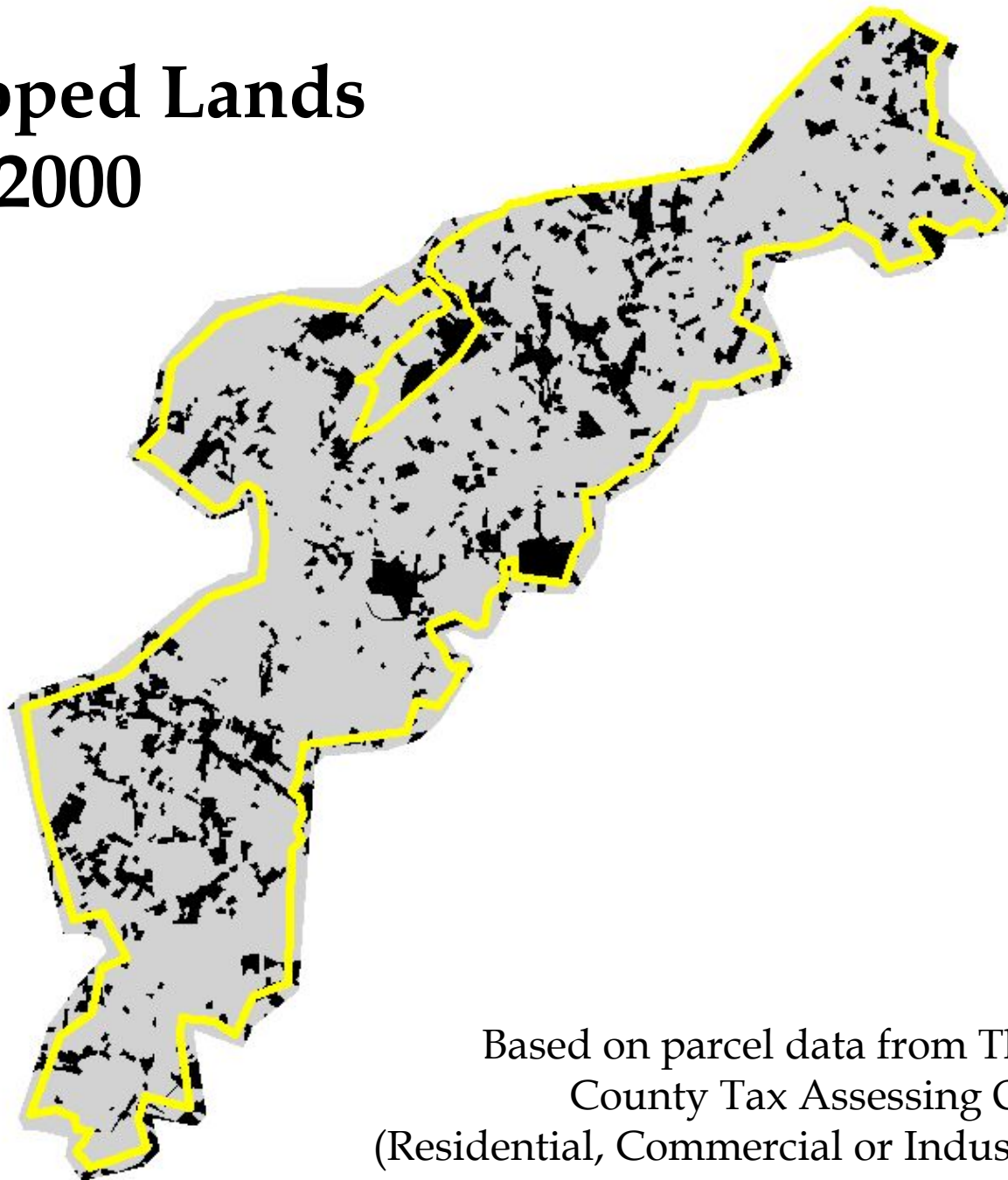
Adams County Fruitbelt

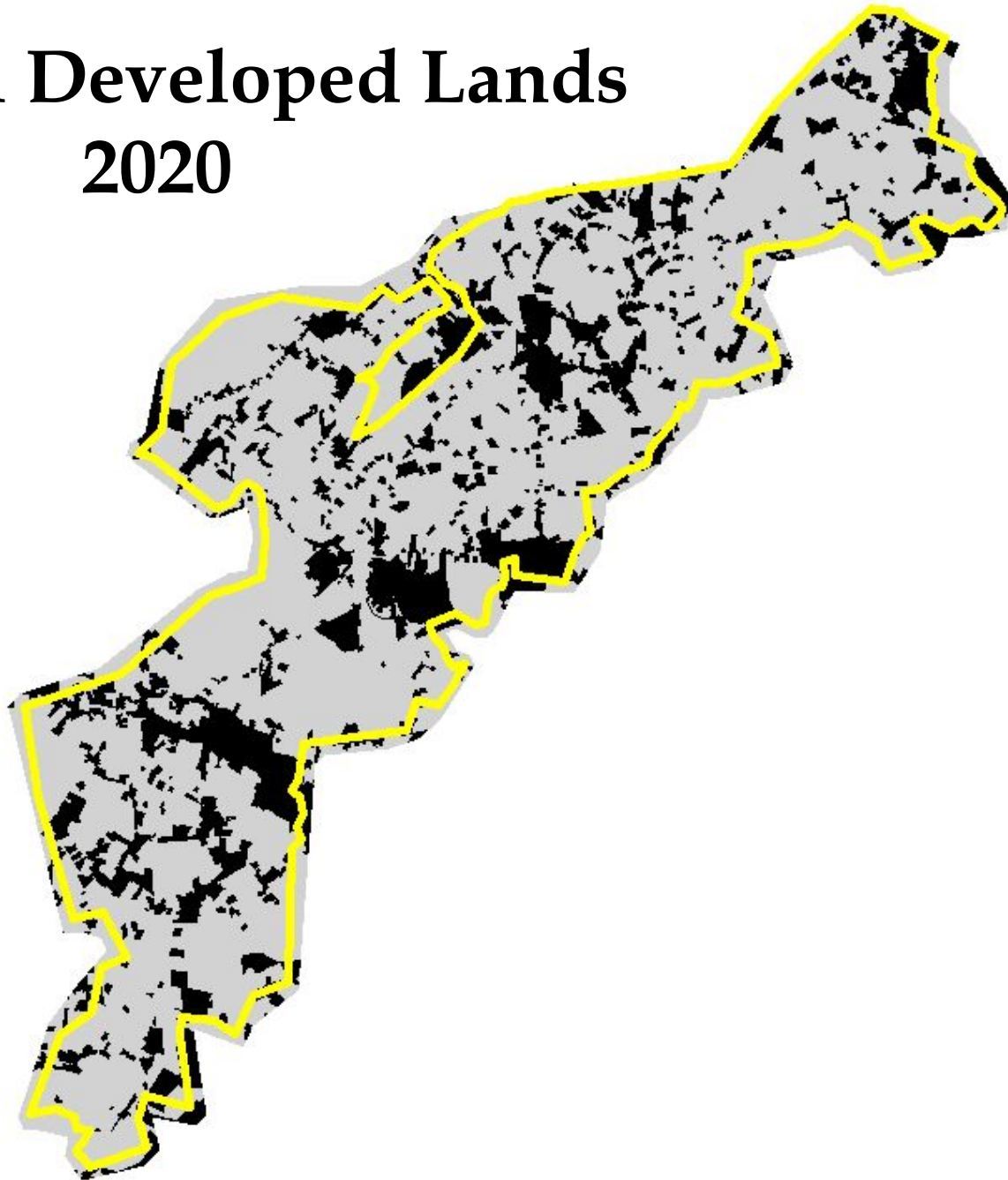


Developed Lands 2000

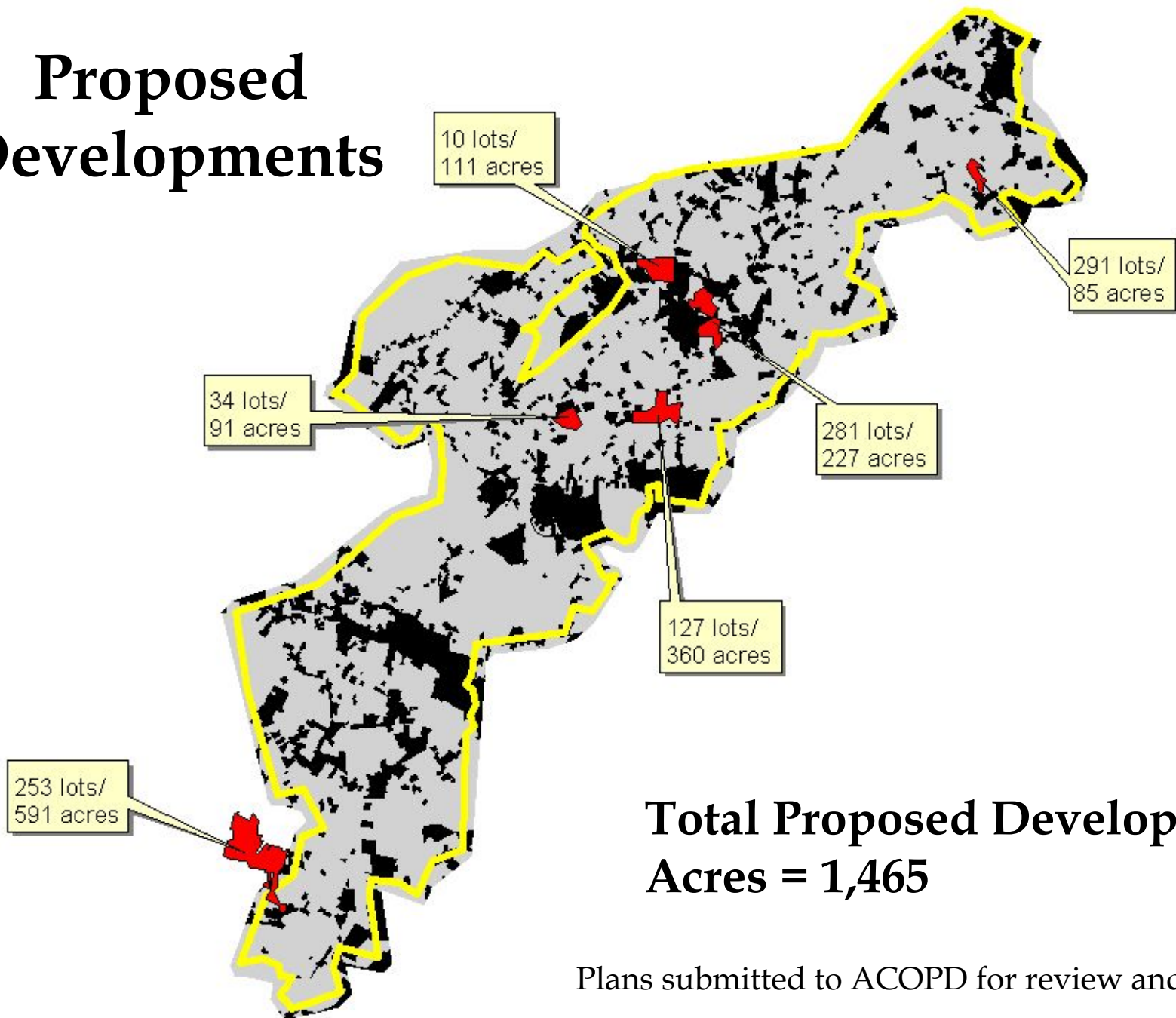

Projected Developed Lands 2020

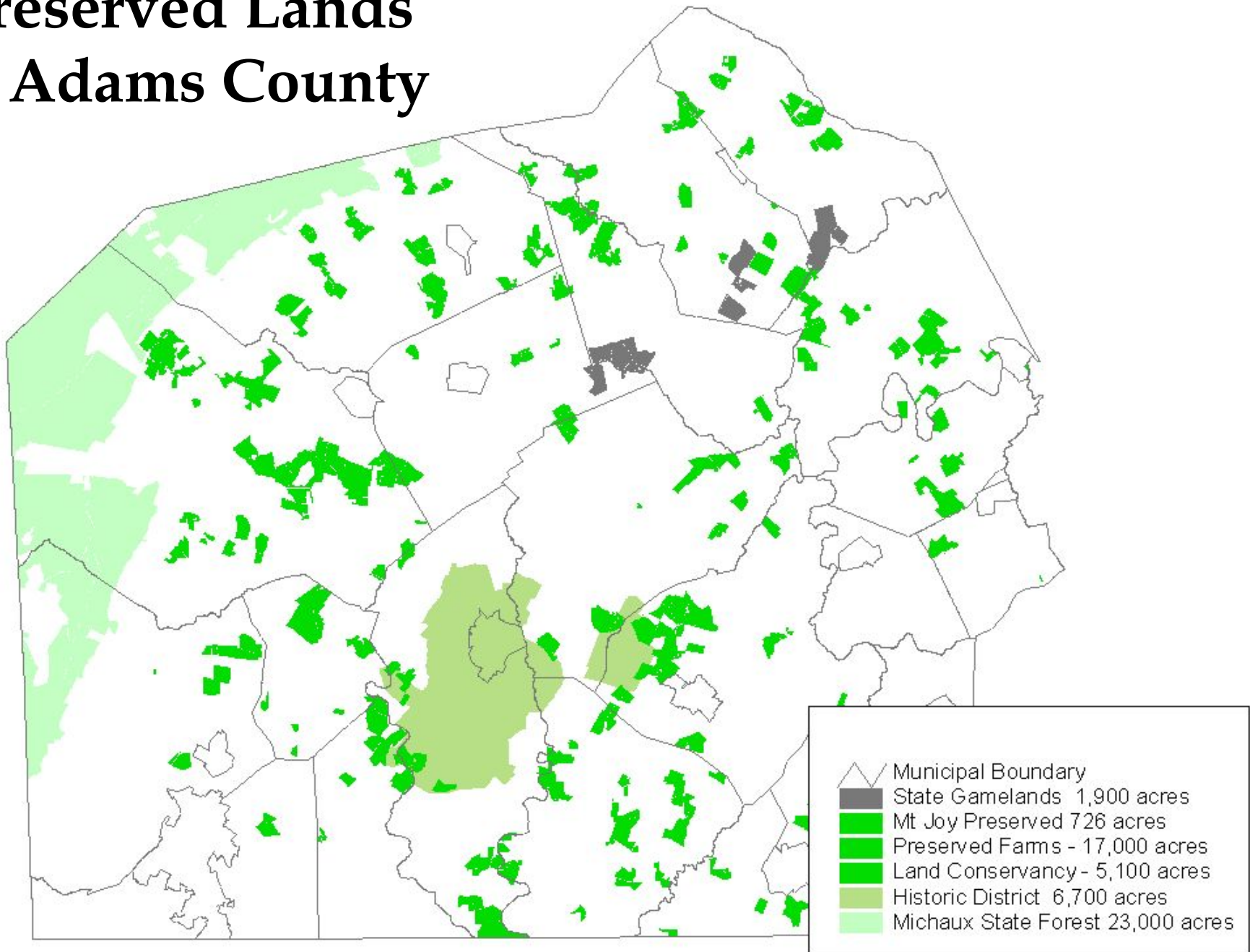

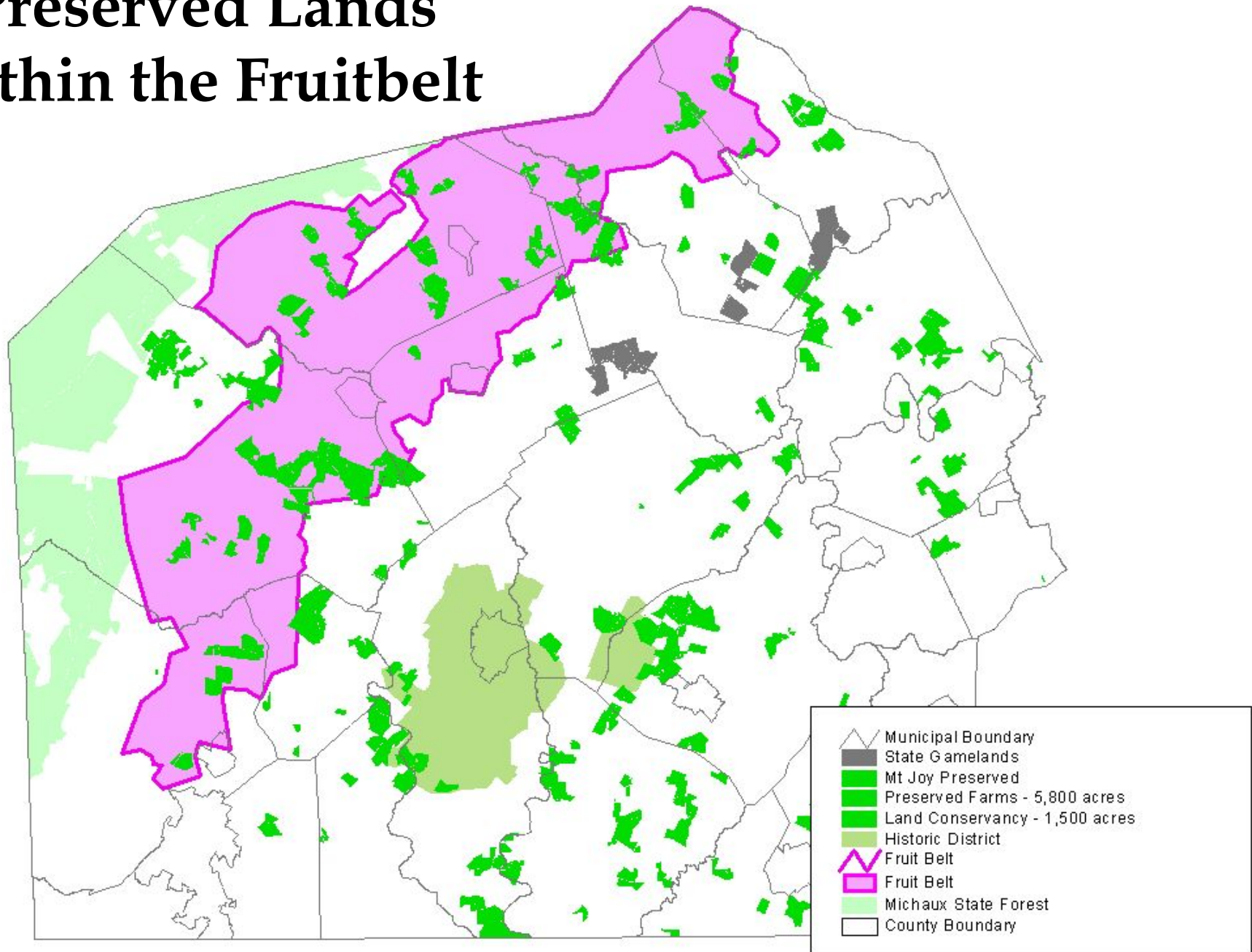

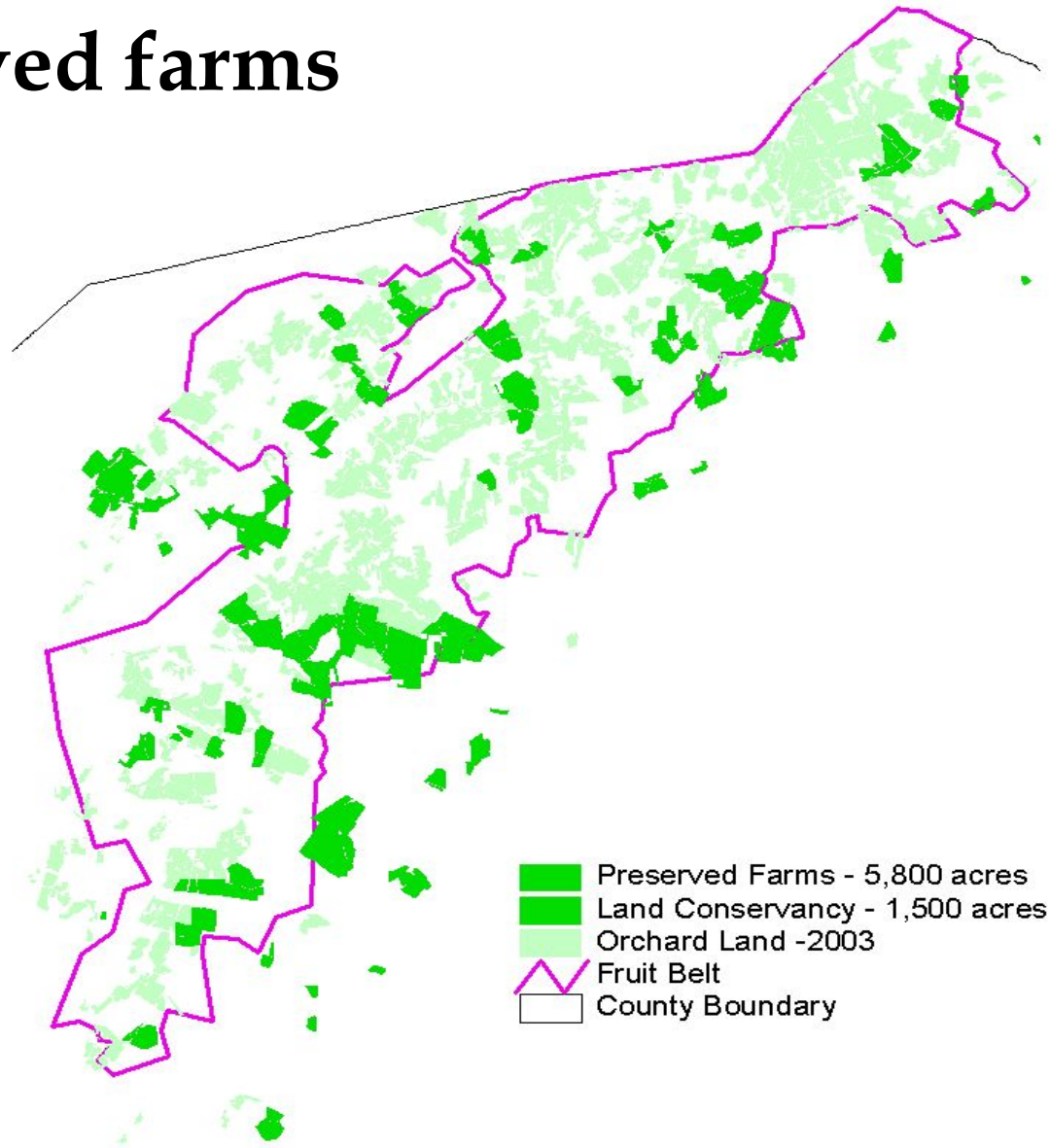

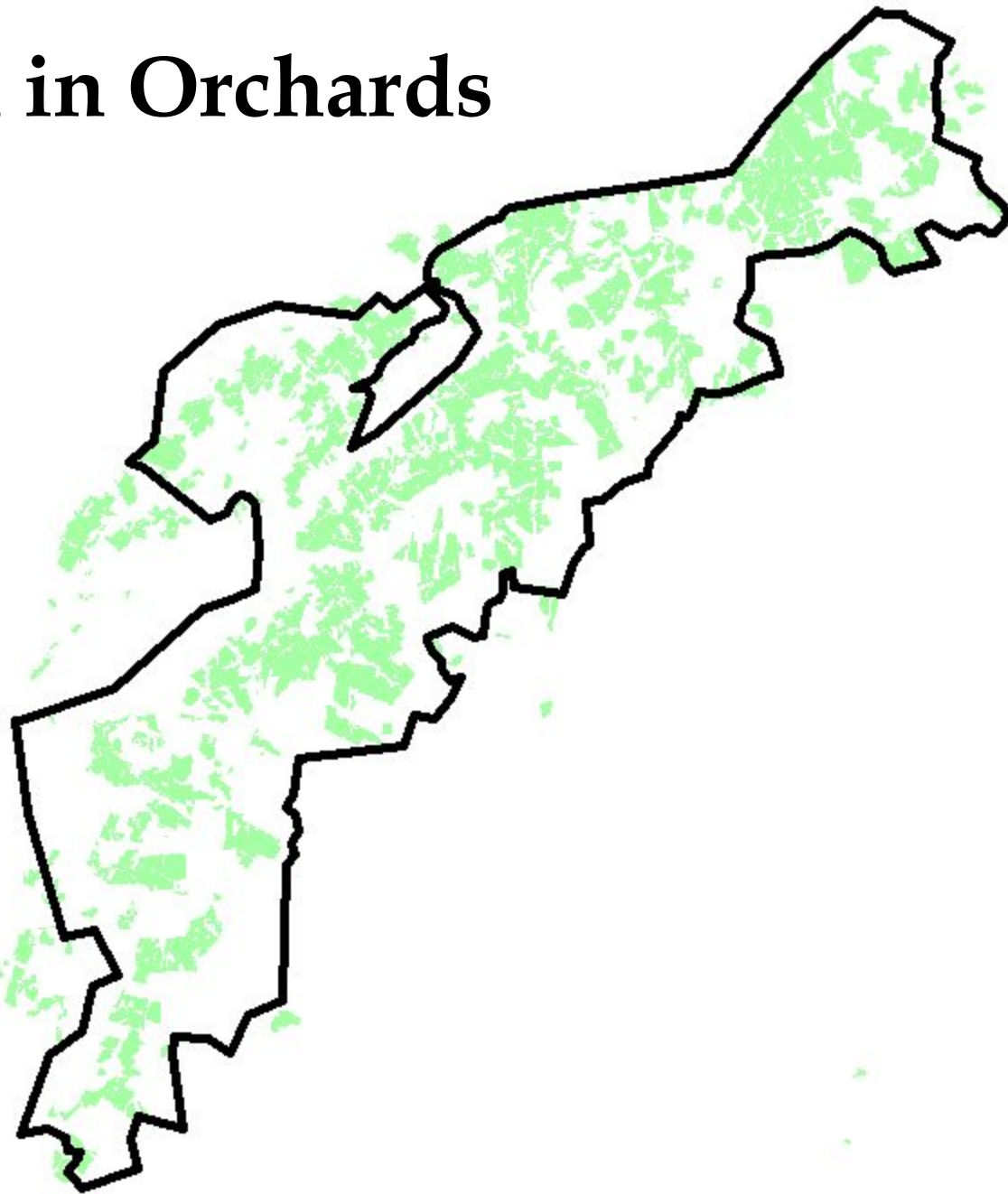
Preserved Lands within the Fruitbelt



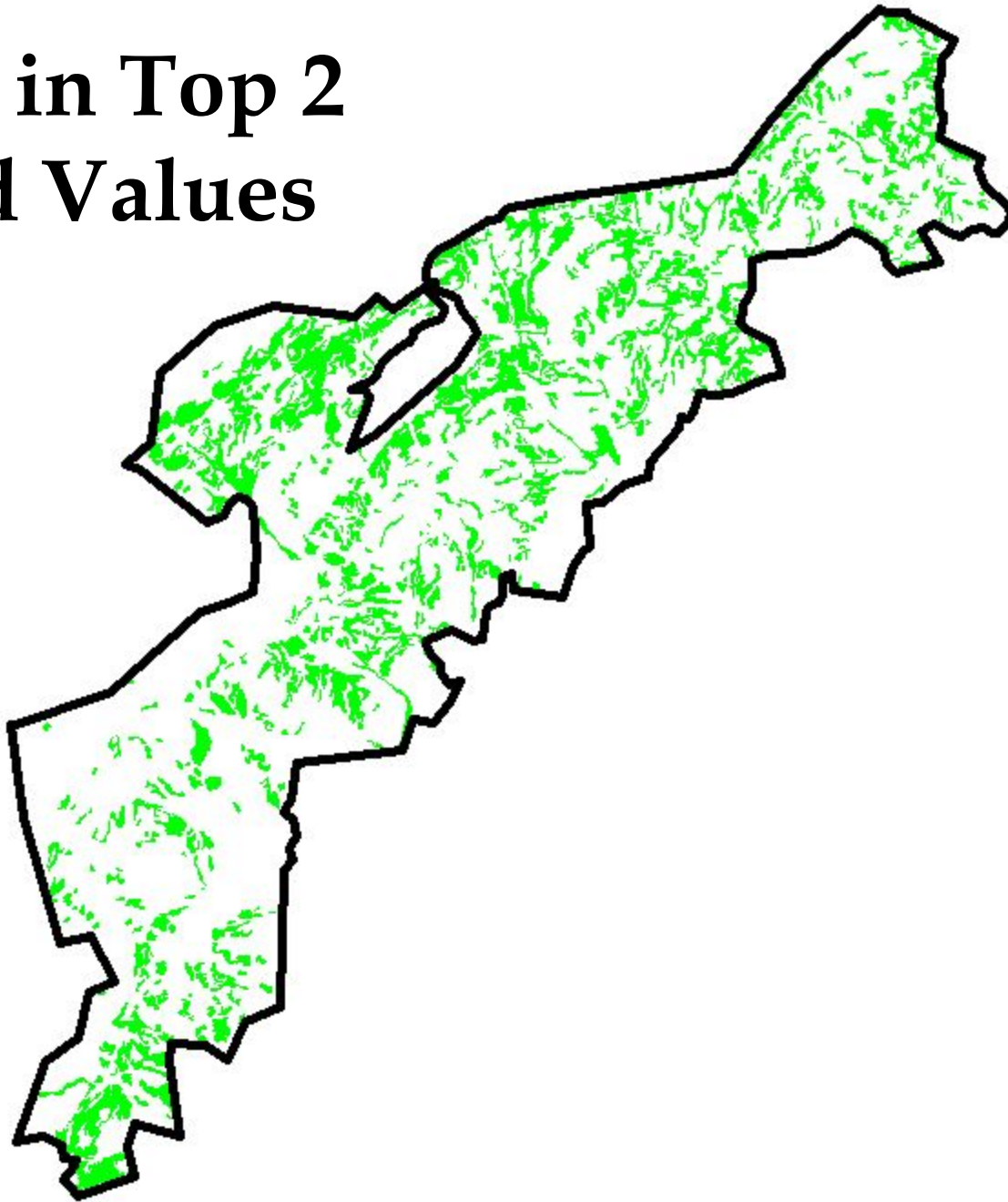
Orchard Land with Preserved farms

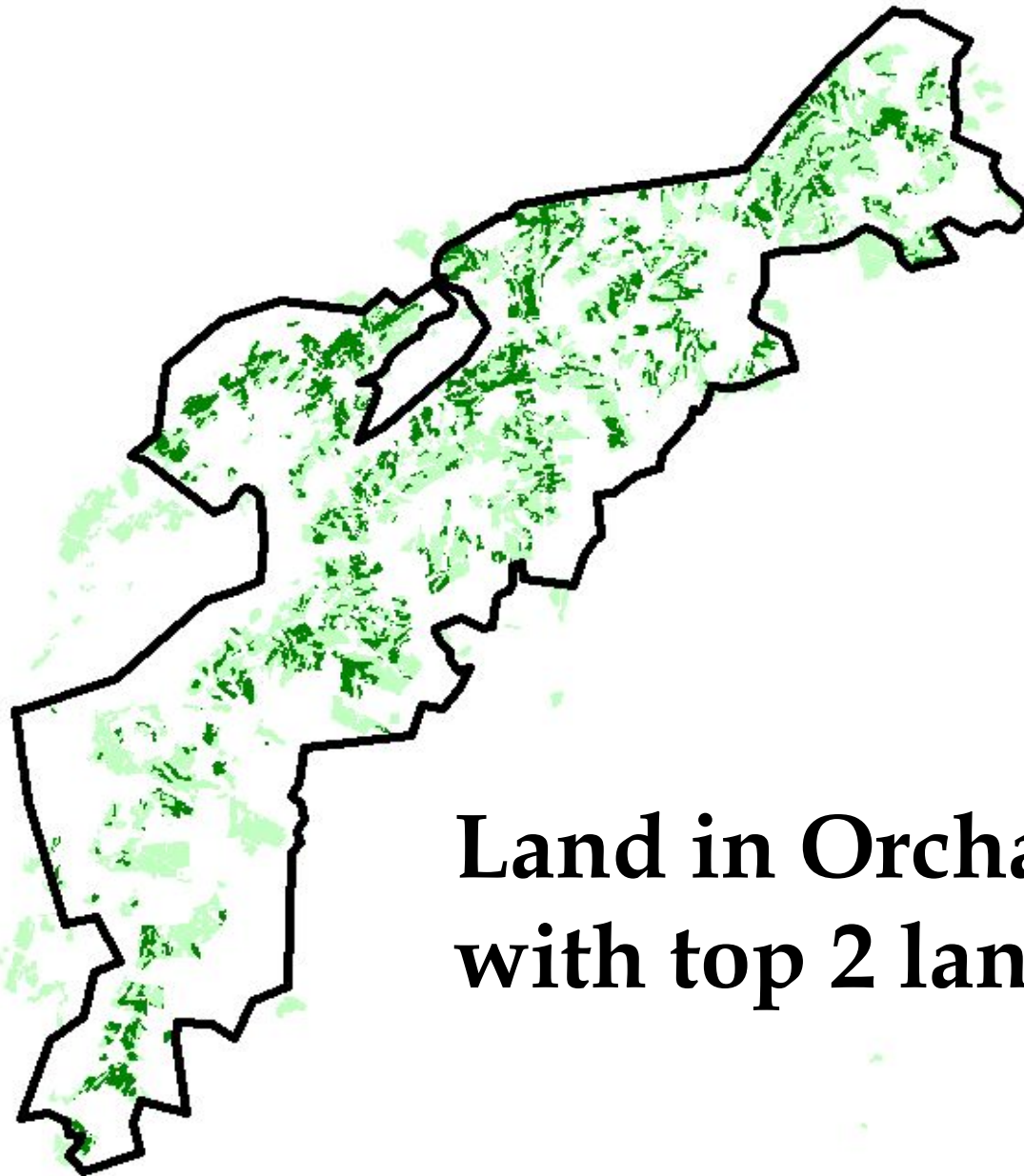


Land in Orchards



Soils in Top 2 Land Values



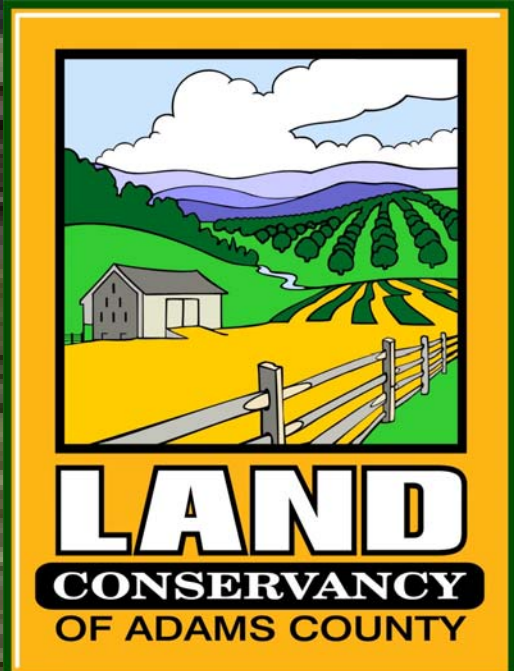




Adams County Comprehensive Plan



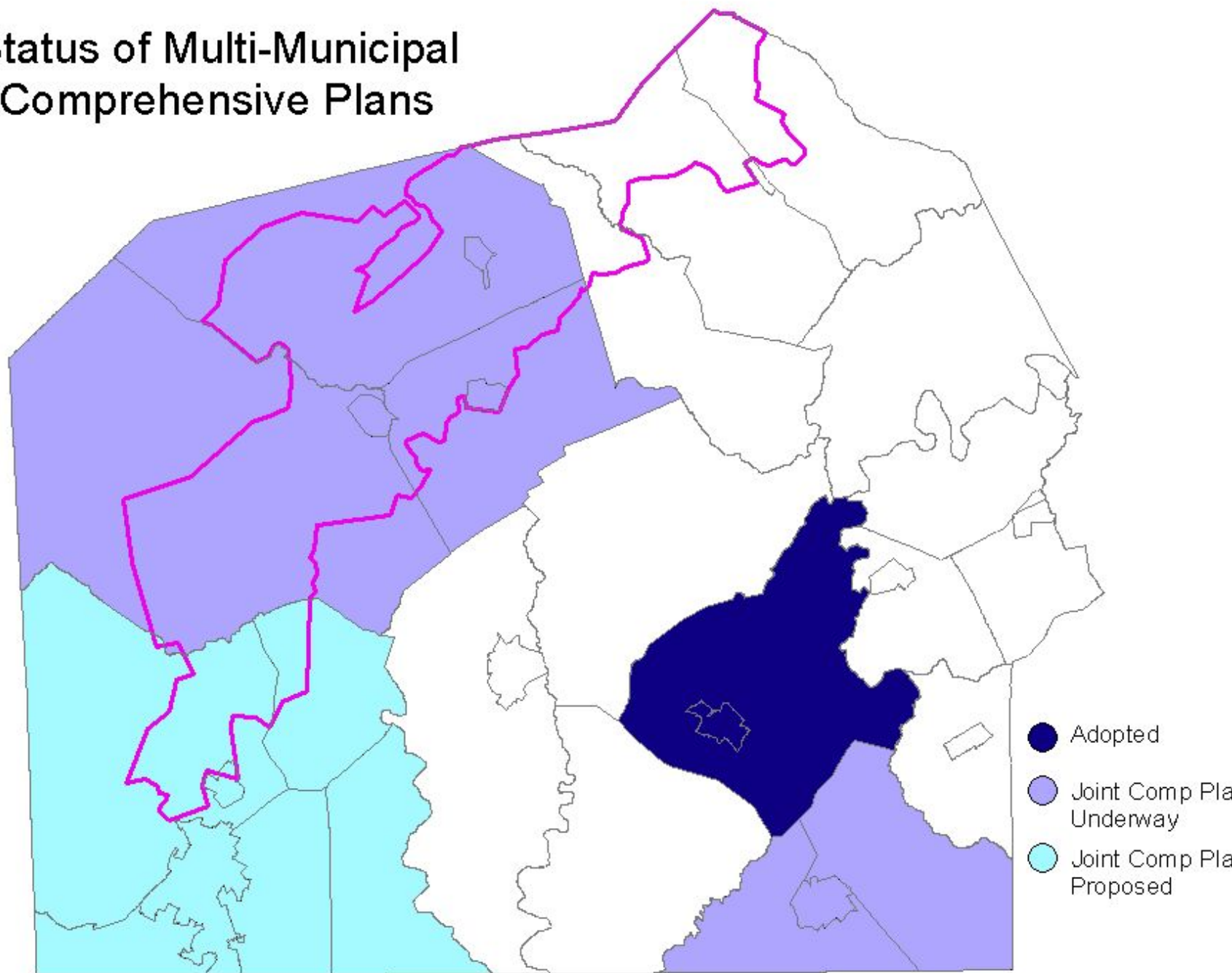
