




# The Chester County Agricultural Development Council (ADC)



The Chester County Agricultural Development Council's purpose is to:

- Help Chester County farmers continue to farm while encouraging additional agricultural opportunities.
- Create an environment to attract new farmers and agricultural activities.
- Educate residents and municipal officials.
- And partner with others to help resolve problems and issues related to agriculture.

# **ADC Work Program**



- Community Outreach to educate the general public on the importance of agriculture.
- Municipal Outreach to educate and work with municipal officials on how to integrate and/or continue to promote agriculture as a land use and viable industry through regulatory land use tools.
- Partnership Committee that inventories the agricultural situation in the County and looks at issues affecting agriculture.

## Community Outreach Initiatives

The ADC partners with the Chester County Buy Fresh Buy Local chapter (administered by PASA) to create an annual food guide. The guide includes features, as well as a map, showing where consumers can find local food.

Economic Development

- Special program for firsttime farm buyers – CCEDC has funded 64 new farms in SE PA in last three years.
- Programs also available for existing farmers looking to buy land, construct or renovate buildings or purchase machinery & equipment.



### Workforce Development – Southeastern PA Agriculture Partnership

Provides training opportunities for farmers and ag and food professionals in SE PA.

- Examples: advanced cheesemaking, improving farm profitability, conferences like PASA, North American Direct Farm Market Association.
- Looking at growing the youth pipeline into agriculture through career showcases, support for regional activities.
