Tree Tenders is a full-day training program that empowers concerned residents to make strides in restoring and caring for their local tree canopy. This training course was developed by the Pennsylvania Horticultural Society (PHS) in collaboration with Penn State Extension, and is based on PHS. The course is designed for lay persons and experts alike. Become one of the TreeTenders restoring and tending your part of the community forest.

Since 2004, DCNR TreeVitalize initiative has supported the program, administered by Environment Erie in Erie County.

Course cost is \$25.00. Registration is required by March 7.
