




INTRODUCTION

The Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission has aerial photographs taken of the entire 3833 square mile Delaware Valley region every five years. These photos are taken from an altitude of 12,000 feet with modern high-

Each of the photographs is enlarged to make a reproducible photo atlas sheet showing about 3.7 square miles of land area.

RELATING THE PHOTO ATLAS SHEETS TO OTHER MAPS

The photo atlas sheets are designed to be readily used with either the U.S. Geological Survey's 71/2 minute quadrangles or with DVRPC's 1 inch=2000 feet scale Regional Base maps (described on the other side of this

Eighteen photo atlas sheets at either scale may be joined together to show a picture of the land area represented by a single USGS quadrangle or DVRPC regional base map. Conversely, a single photo atlas sheet provides a detailed picture of a portion of either of these maps.

PHOTO ATLAS SHEETS FROM PREVIOUS YEARS


DVRPC has photo atlas sheets for 1959 and for every fifth year beginning with 1965. These archival atlas sheets, used in conjunction with the most recent series, provide an historic record of the changes that have occurred in the various parts of the Delaware Valley over the years.

ORDERING PHOTO ATLAS SHEETS

Black line diazo prints of any DVRPC's photo atlas sheets may be ordered individually or in sets to cover a needed area.

Orders may be placed by written request, by telephone or by visiting the service counter at the Commission offices.

FEATURES SHOWN

Each photo atlas sheet is a picture of the land's surface and clearly depicts such features as roads, land use, housing patterns, farmland, rivers, forests, open space and more.

The photos are particularly useful in determining development patterns, locating specific natural or man-made features, identifying industrial sites and transportation facilities or for simply providing a frame of reference for planning and

SCALE OF PHOTO ATLAS SHEETS


The photo atlas sheets are available at two scales: 1 inch=400 feet and 1 inch=800 feet. Prints at the 400 scale measure 26 inches by 36 inches while those at the 800 scale are 13 inches by 18 inches.

Each photo atlas sheet overlaps the adjacent sheets, allowing the prints to be joined together to show a larger land area.

SELECTING PHOTO ATLAS SHEETS

The photo atlas sheet index presented on the reverse side of this sheet shows the entire ninecounty DVRPC region divided into 1330 photo atlas sheets at either the 400 or the 800 foot

Each photo atlas sheet has its own "A" and "B" number. Any single sheet may be selected by specifying its "A" (vertical column) number and its "B" (horizontal row) number. For example, photo atlas sheet A29 B40 covers Conshohocken and West Conshohocken in Montgomery County.

INTRODUCTION

The DVRPC has produced a set of regional Base Maps based on the U.S. Geological Survey 71/2 minute quadrangles. These maps form a set of 96 matching sheets, each measuring approximately 17×23 inches with a scale of 1 inch=2000 feet.

A second set of maps, at a scale of 1 inch=1 mile, covers the nine-county region with eleven sheets, each measuring 30"×30".

Both of these map series are updated every five years to keep them abreast of changes within the region.

FEATURES SHOWN

Features shown on the maps include streets and highways, railroads, landmark buildings such as schools and hospitals, municipal and county boundaries and natural features such as streams, lakes and rivers.

The Photo Atlas Sheet Index on the reverse side of this sheet provides

additional geographic detail to aid in the selection of desired maps.

A VARIETY OF USES

These maps provide an excellent base for plotting information such as population concentrations or land uses, for locating school or voting district boundaries, for industrial or real estate planning, for marketing analysis and many other


SELECTING MAP SHEETS



The small solid numbers identify the 2000' sheets individually and the large open-face numbers label the 1 mile series

ORDERING COPIES OF THE MAPS


As with the photo atlas sheets, copies of the maps are available as black line diazo prints. They may be ordered either individually or in sets to cover a desired area.

Orders may be placed in writing, by telephone or in person. Costs vary, depending on sizes and quantities. Current prices will be furnished on request.






King of Prussia and Vicinity - 1959





