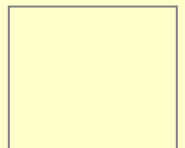

The BHP is Pennsylvania's State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO), responsible for implementing state and federal historic preservation programs throughout the Commonwealth. Bill has twenty-five years of experience working with federal and state historic preservation programs in Pennsylvania, Illinois and Nebraska and has also worked in the private sector, for several years managing two businesses in an historic downtown. Bill represents the BHP in Pennsylvania's western 26 counties. Through Bill the BHP provides technical preservation assistance to municipalities, advocacy groups, business groups, planning commissions, Historic Architecture Review Boards, community development advocates, Main Street and Elm Street programs and property owners.

Preservation Pennsylvania, Inc. is a statewide non-profit organization dedicated to the preservation of Pennsylvania's historic resources.
